The youth exchange

The aim of the youth exchange is to understand the ecological impact of the fast fashion industry and our clothing habit, and explore alternatives to fast fashion.

During the project, we will be asking ourselves (and answering) questions such as:

- How much clothing is thrown away yearly?
- How much textile waste is produced by a singular person?
- What are the ecological implications? What are the manufacturing conditions?

- Theory & workshops to understand the journey from raw materials to our closet
- Sewing workshop
- Visiting local organizations (second hand shops, wool workshop)
- organize a "second hand" fashion show in order to promote the "repaired" clothes
- Emotional circles
- Intercultural evenings
- Free day / Local event

The methodology

- Participative methods
- Learning by doing
- Involvement in all the daily tasks
- Non-formal education tools
- Non-formal and informal learnings

Those methods aim to develop critical thinking, sense of analysis and the capacity to share our opinion with others.

- Local, seasonal and organic food (as much as we can)

Intercultural Evenings

Each country team will have the opportunity to share some element of their culture during the youth exchange. There will be three nights of:

- **The intercultural buffet**: Every country team is going to have time to cook or bring a small something to present some dish or snacks.
- **The cabaret**: In a creative way, each country team can present some things of their countries: something important to them, that they like or dislike about the place where they live, etc.





The place of the youth exchange

The youth exchange will take place in **Saint Lizier** (09200), in a holiday cottage called "**Au pays des traces**". You can find more info about the place <u>here</u>.

The hosting venue offers **3 dormitory rooms with 8** beds, **3 common bathrooms**, kitchen with dining room, activity room and beautiful outdoors for activities (if the weather allows).

How to come to the venue

You will have to come to "Toulouse", which is the closest city to us (Barcelona is not so far away from us too). And then come to "Boussens" where we will pick you up with the vans to go to the place of the training course.

If you come by plane, the closest airport is "Toulouse-Blagnac Airport".

From the airport

Look at the info on the airport website. The name of the train station stop is "Marengo-**SNCF**". If you want to see a map of the **public transport** in Toulouse you can look at Tisseo.





You can easily come by bus or train, which is usually not so expensive.

Toulouse train station

To catch a train to **Boussens**, you will have to go to the main train station of Toulouse called "Toulouse-Matabiau" or "Marengo-SNCF". If you arrive by train or bus, you are probably already at the good place. The Bus station is next to the train station.





To Boussens:

Take a train in the direction of "Montréjeau", "Saint-Gaudens" or "Tarbes-Lourdes"



→ Check that **Boussens** is among the stops just in case... When you buy your ticket (at a counter or a machine) you can get a **25% discount** if you are **younger than 26** or you are a **student (possible online discount)**



- You should arrive to Toulouse on the 14th of June at 16:00 the latest
- The departure from Toulouse on the 26th of June no earlier than 10:00 AM

To Saint Lizier/ Au pays des traces :

Once in "Boussens", there will be someone picking you up for the last step of your journey: a minivan ride!

→ Know that you should arrive at **6:36 PM on the 14th of June in Boussens train station**. (train living from Toulouse at 5:40 PM). There won't be no other time to pick you up!







Green travel and transport costs

When possible, we really want to **promote green travel** (travelling to and from the youth exchange without taking any plane). We think it makes sense with our **ecological values and the topic of this youth exchange**. Of course, some countries are closest so it's more doable, and it's in those cases that we would really want to **work together to help the participants to use this green travel.**

There is a **flat rate to reimburse participants** of their transport according to the number of kilometers. In the case where people use only green travels, there is an **extra amount of money to cover for possible extra costs** (for example, a night in a hostel if the travel takes more than a day).

About the reimbursement: Participants have to buy the tickets, and we will then reimburse them (if this is not possible, please contact us). We always do our best to make the reimbursement within 2 to 3 months after the training. 6 months after will be our very maximum.

We will **reimburse the exact amount of the travel costs** if the costs are less than the rate. If it is exceeded, the participant will have to pay the difference. We can reimburse participants directly or the partner organization (we can discuss this together before the project with each partner).

PARTICIPANTS HAVE TO KEEP ALL THE TICKETS FROM THE TRAVEL.

(if not we won't be able to make the reimbursement)

Ask for an invoice/receipt for each of your travel tickets and keep them all carefully for us !!!

Keep also your boarding passes!

We need to see the place of departure, place or arrival, the time and your name.

Be careful with Ryanair app, they delete the boarding pass after the flight so download it before!

If you arrive one or two days before or if you go back one or two days after, you will have to find another place to stay. Toulouse, Bordeaux, Montpellier, Carcassone are nice cities around here. The French Pyrenees are beautiful. There are many beautiful places to be discovered:)

There is also a <u>youth hostel</u> in Toulouse. The price is **25.80 €/person/night.**
